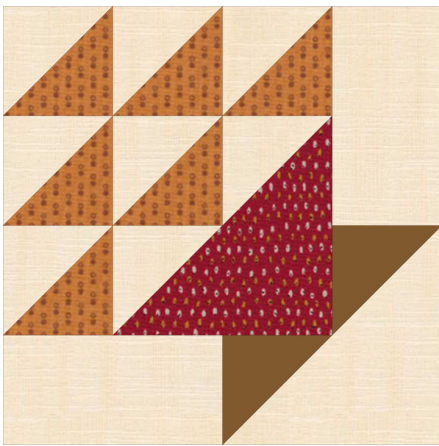








Underground Railroad BOM - Month 12

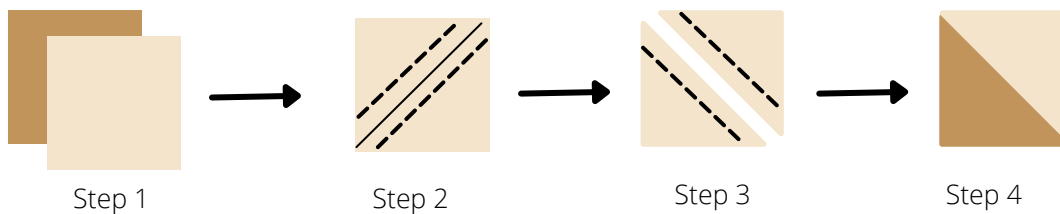
Basket Block



Fabric pieces needed

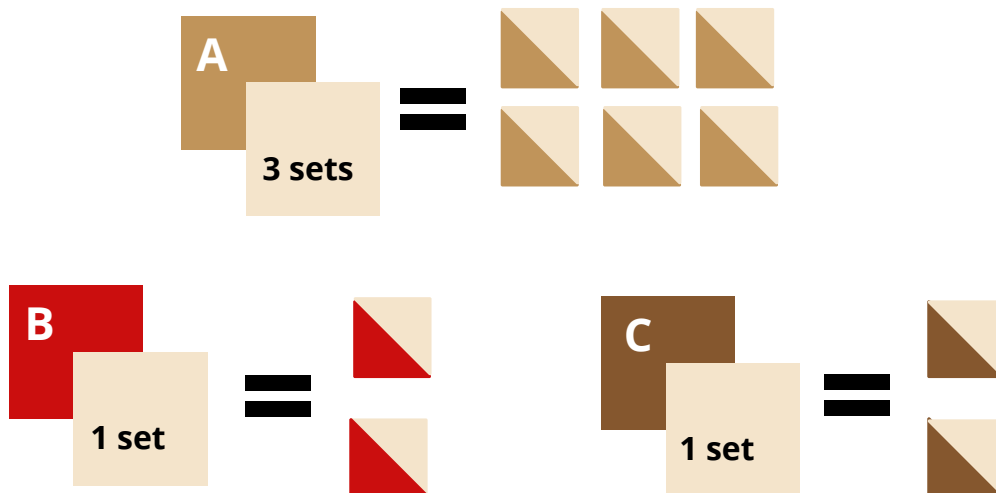
-  Fabric A - (3) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares
-  Fabric B - (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square
-  Fabric C - (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square
-  Background: (2) 3-1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
-  (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square
-  (5) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares

Making 2-at-a-time Half Square Triangles (HST)



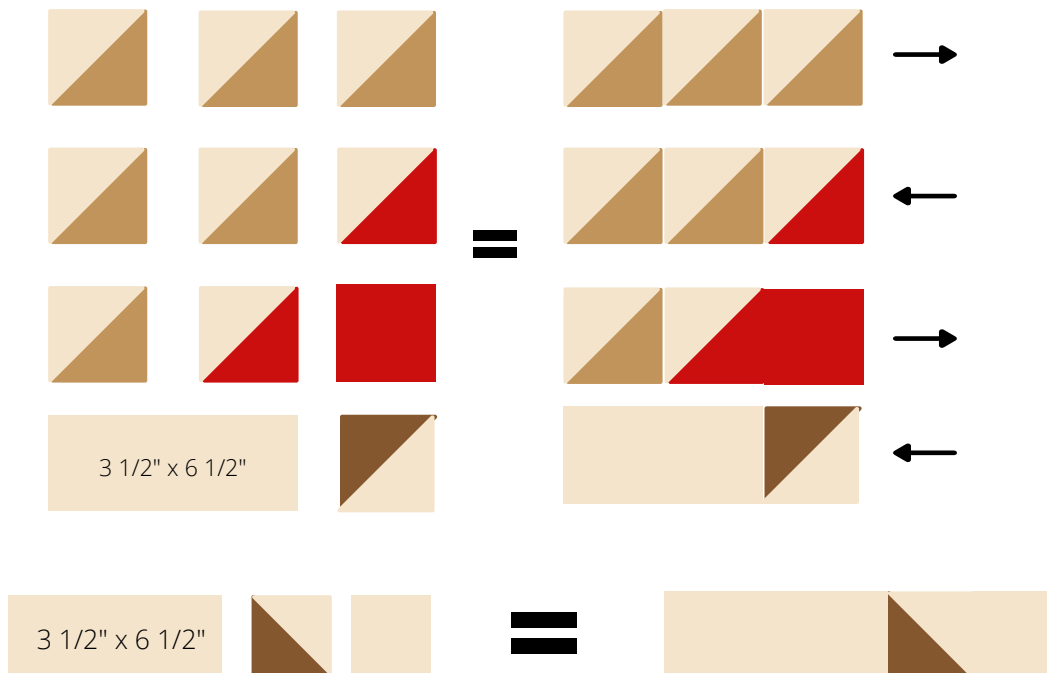
- Step 1 - Pair a color 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square with a background 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square.
- Step 2 - Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" background square. With right sides together, stitch 1/4 inch from each side of the drawn line.
- Step 3 - Cut on the drawn line.
- Step 4 - Open and press toward dark fabric. Trim each HST to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2".

1. Pair together the 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" color and 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" background squares and make 2 at a time HST following instructions above.

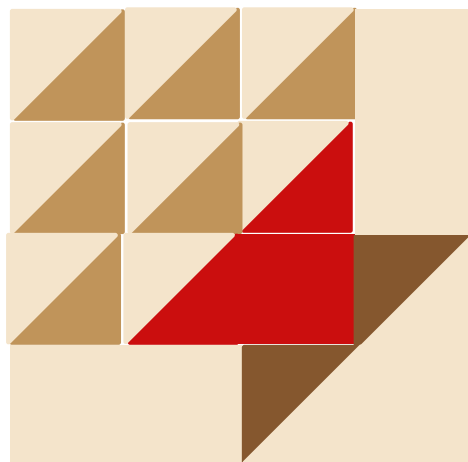


Block Assembly Diagram

2. Lay out your pieces and sew together 4 rows. Press in direction of arrows, then sew rows together



2. Sew the remaining row together (3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle, Fabric C HST and 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" background square) and attach to the right side of your block. This completes your block!



Assembling Quilt Top

Need: 7/8 yard of fabric

Cut (11) 2 1/2" x WOF strips

Subcut (8) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips

(3) 2 1/2" by 40.5" strips

(2) 2 1/2" x 45" *(sew strips together to achieve length)*

(2) 2 1/2" x 55" *(sew strips together to achieve length)*
