

## Crossroads Block Underground Railroad BOM - Month 4


- Color A Cut (4) 4 3/4" squares
  - Color B Cut (1) 4 3/4" squares
  - Background Cut (2) 5" squares (block sides) Cut (2) 4" squares (block corners)




- 1. Take the two 5" background squares and cut in half diagnonally corner to corner, to make 4 triangles. (Fig. 1.)
- 2. Repeat Step 1 with the two 4" background squares. Set aside.




3. Matching right sides together, stitch 1 Color A square on opposite sides of the Color B Square. (Fig. 2) Press seams toward Color B square.




- 4. Matching right sides together, place a 5" background triangle onto a Color A square as shown. (Fig. 3). Stitch. Open and press toward background. **Note**: The top edge of the triangle should be even with the top of the square. The triangle point will hang off about 1/4 beyond square. Do not trim until block is finished.
- 5. Matching right sides, place another 5" background triangle on the opposite side of the square and stitch. Open and press toward background. (Fig. 4)



6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5, to make another unit with remaining Color A square and 5" triangles.



7. Sew the triangle units to the top and bottom of middle section. Press. (Fig. 5)



8. To form the corners, sew the 4" triangles to the Color A squares and press toward background. (Fig. 6) Trim off triangle edges to square your block.
