



Underground Railroad BOM - Month 10 FLYING GEESE BLOCK

Fabric Needed

Background: (8) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares

Color 1: (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares

Color 2: (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares

Color 3: (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares

Color 4: (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares

Two at a time Half Square Triangles (HST).

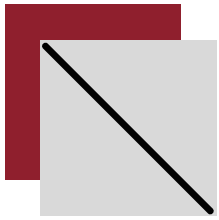

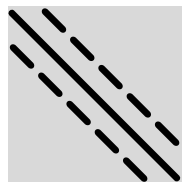

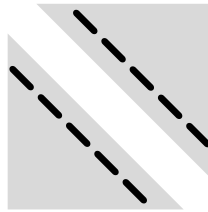

1. Pair each 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" color square with a 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" background square, right sides together. (Fig. 1)
2. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all background squares. (Fig. 1)
3. Stitch 1/4" from the drawn line, on both sides. (Fig. 2)
4. Cut on the draw line. (Fig. 3). You will have a total of 16 HST.
5. Open and press toward the darker fabric. (Fig. 4)
6. Trim each HST to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.
7. Sew two same color HSTs together in pairs. Press seams open. You will have 2 sets of each color. (Fig. 5)

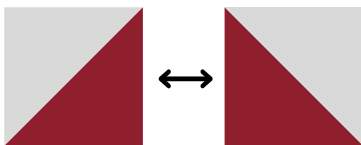

8. Sew two like color geese together one on top of the other as shown in Fig. 6. You will have 4 sets.

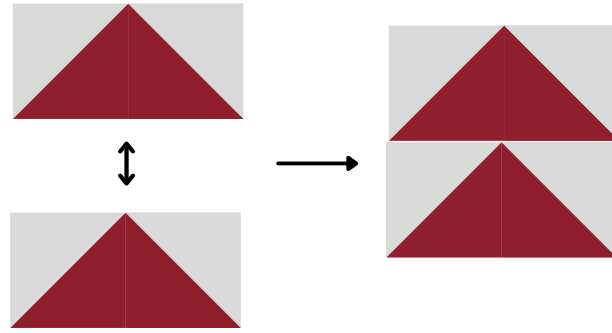

9. Sew units together as shown below in Fig. 7. Press top row to the right, and the bottom row to the left..

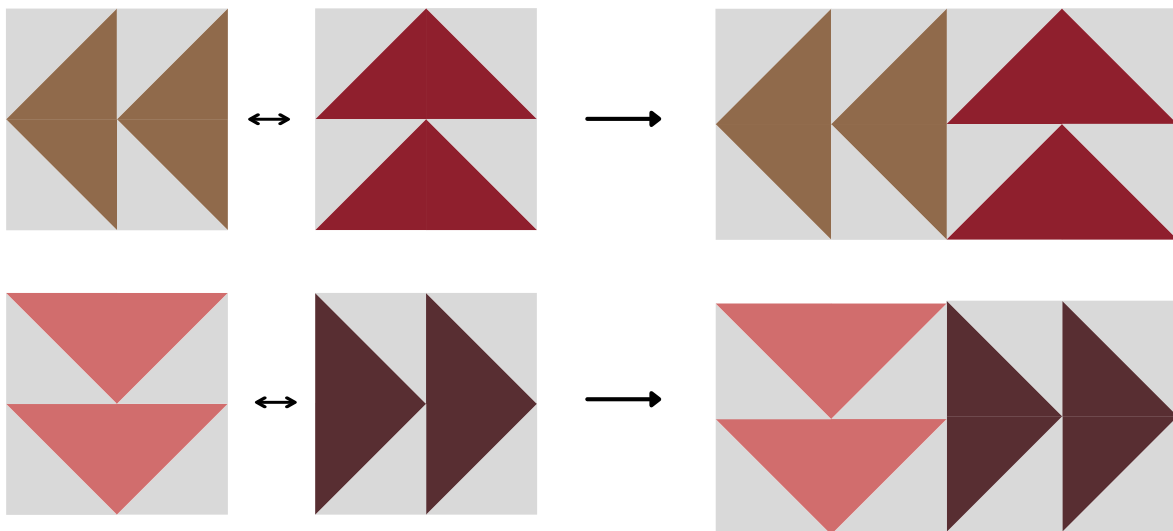

10. Sew top and bottom rows together (press),
